

What To Do If You Get a Robocall

If you have a telephone, robocalls may be ruining your day. The Federal Trade Commission is aware robocalls are increasing on landline telephones and cell phones. If you answer the phone and hear a recorded message instead of a live person, it's a robocall. If the recording is a sales message and you haven't given your written permission to get calls from the company on the other end, the call is illegal period.

When you get an illegal robocall, here's what to do. Hang up the phone. Don't press one to speak to a live operator. And don't press any other number to get off the list. If you respond by pressing any number, it will probably just lead to more robocalls.

You can contact NEMR Telecom and add "Select Call Rejection" to your telephone service. It is a free service but remember that telemarketers change caller ID information easily and often. Most likely blocking phone numbers will not stop the robocalls. It might not be worth the time to block a number that will change. Finally, contact the FTC to report your experience. You can do that online at ftc.gov or by calling 1-877-FTC-HELP. To learn more about illegal robocalls and what the FTC is doing to stop them, visit ftc.gov/robocalls.
