

NEMR Telecom is pleased to announce our continued participation in the Foundation for Rural Services (FRS) Scholarship Program. FRS awards a one-time \$2,500 scholarship to students from rural America for their first year of college, university or vocational-technical school. Should a 857-4445 student from our service area be selected to receive one of the scholarships (\$2,000 each), we will contribute an additional \$500 to the scholarship, bringing the total one-time scholarship award to \$2,500. The FRS College Scholarship Program seeks to encourage students to return to their rural communities upon completing their education.

FRS is an affiliate of the National Telephone Cooperative Association (NTCA), an Arlington, VA based trade organization of independent telephone companies and co-ops from across the country.

To be eligible you must meet all the following criteria:

- 1. Be a graduating high school senior.
- 2. Receive your local telephone service from NEMR Telecom.
- 3. Be enrolled (next year) in an accredited two-year or four-year college, university or vocational technical school.
- 4. Have at least a C grade point average.
- 5. Submit completed application with essay.
- 6. Express an interest to work in a rural community following graduation.
- 7. Be sponsored by NEMR Telecom.

Applications are available through your high school counselor, from our business office or at FRS's web site, www.frs.org. Your completed application should be sent directly to our business office and must be received by us no later than February 15th. Applications received after that date will not be accepted. MODEM-A device that connects a computer to a phone line allowing the computer to talk to other computers through the phone system.

NETIQUETTE-Also called digital etiquette. Guidelines to behave appropriately online.

PHISHING-Attempting to acquire personal or financial information by masquerading as a trustworthy entity.

USERNAME-A unique name a person uses to access a computer program or system.

WIRELESS NETWORK-A network that allows devices to communicate using radio or light transmissions instead of wires.



- Push the Input button on the bottom left until you find the source your nemr tv is plugged into and click on that source.

Example: HDMI 1-HDMI 2-Componet
